

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 5th day of May, 1947, that:

WHEREAS, due to drought conditions it is necessary to purchase pumping equipment for operating the well at the I. D. Ranch.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that an engine and a counter-balanced pump jack be purchased and installed immediately at the I. D. Ranch headquarters. Funds in the amount of \$700.00 are hereby authorized to be expended from Tribal Funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on May 5, 1947, by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
