

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 5th day of May, 1947, that :

WHEREAS, it is necessary to divide the old Cross F summer range for the purebred and commercial herd of the Old Folks Herd to provide for better management and utilization of the range.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$3000.00 on deposit to the credit of the Tribe at Fort Apache Agency be hereby authorized for expenditures to accomplish the necessary fences on the I. D. range.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on May 5th, 1947, by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
