

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 9th day of June, 1947, that:

WHEREAS, the Relief Funds heretofore provided for this fiscal year have not been adequate to meet the needs of the Indian people,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that \$1,900.00 of funds now on deposit in individual Indian money accounts to the credit of the Tribe is hereby authorized to be used for relief purposes for the remainder of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1947.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on June 9, 1947, by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
