

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Reservation in regular session this 1st day of August, 1947, that:

WHEREAS, there has been a considerable reduction in funds available for administrative work at the Fort Apache Agency for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1947, and

WHEREAS, the salary of Clerk-Typist, CAF-4, Position 14.8 has been paid from the fund "Salaries and Expenses, Reservation Administration", and since it is desired that this position be retained at the Fort Apache Agency, the Council requests that his position be permanently transferred from "Salaries and Expenses, Reservation Administration" to "Proceeds of Labor, Fort Apache Indians, Arizona (Support)".

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on August 1, 1947, by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
