

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Reservation in regular session this 1st day of August, 1947, that:

WHEREAS, appropriated funds are not available for paying the Special Officer that the Tribal Council hereby establish a position of Chief of Police which shall be filled by a member of the tribe at a salary of \$150.00 per month, salary of said position to be paid from individual Indian money account to the credit of the tribe on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on August 1, 1947, by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c), of the Constitution and By-Laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
