

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that,

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 219, adopted on August 1, 1947 provided for the employment of a Game Warden for the Maverick Area on the Fort Apache Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Council now desires to place this position of Game Warden on a permanent basis,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Resolution No. 219 is hereby amended to provide that a Game Warden for the Maverick area on the Fort Apache Reservation be employed on a permanent basis at a salary of \$150.00 per month.

There is also authorized the expenditure of not to exceed over \$200.00 per year for the purchase of hay and grain for saddle horses required by the Game Warden, and not to exceed \$200.00 per year for the operation, repair and upkeep of a pickup truck or other automobile that may be required for the Game Warden's use from time to time.

The funds for salary and expenses of this position are hereby authorized to be paid from Tribal Funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency to the credit of the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on October 9, 1947, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
