

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that,

In order to increase the amount of range water development available, by cooperative work with the Production and Marketing Administration, that \$2000.00 of funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency to the credit of the Tribe be made available for additional range water development work during the calendar year 1947.

The foregoing resolution was on October 9, 1947, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
