

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that,

In order to provide for protection of wildlife and enforcement of game laws and regulations that there is hereby authorized the establishment of a Game Warden for the north boundary area of the Fort Apache Reservation to be employed from October 16 through December 31, 1947.

The salary of the Game Warden appointed shall be at the rate of \$140.00 per month for the period authorized, and in addition there is hereby authorized expenditure of not to exceed \$50.00 for the purchase of hay and grain for saddle horses used by the Game Warden. The salary and expenses of this position are hereby authorized to be paid from tribal funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency to the credit of the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on October 10, 1947, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d), of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
