

RESOLUTION
of the
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE
of the
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

NO. 237

WHEREAS, Tribal Resolution Number 233 adopted by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe on January 8, 1948 does authorize the employment of Mr. James E. Curry, Attorney at Law, Washington, D. C. to represent the Tribe in matters pertaining to claims of the Tribe against the United States before the Indian Claims Commission, and

WHEREAS, said Resolution Number 233 does provide that a contract be drawn setting forth the conditions and stipulations of said employment, and that said contract be approved by the Tribal Council and the Secretary of the Interior; now,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in special session this 19th day of January, 1948 does hereby approve the contract drawn to cover the conditions and stipulations of the employment of James E. Curry, Attorney at Law in representing the White Mountain Apache Tribe in claims of the tribe against the United States before the Indian Claims Commission; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is authorized to sign said contract for the Tribal Council, provided that said contract shall also be approved by the Secretary of the Interior as provided in Article VI, Section 1(b) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution Number 237 was on January 19, 1948 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(b) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
