

RESOLUTION
of the
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE
of the
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the funds appropriated for relief purposes for support and care of indigent Indians of the White Mountain Apache Tribe by tribal resolution No. 205 adopted on May 5, 1947 in the amount of \$18000 is not sufficient to provide adequate relief for the indigent members of the tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council did authorize an increase in the relief grants as recorded in the Minutes of the Council meeting of June 9, 1947; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in special session this 19th day of January, 1948, that there be hereby authorized and appropriated the sum of \$15000 for relief of old and indigent Indians of the tribe for the balance of fiscal year 1948, from tribal funds now on deposit in an Individual Indian Money Account with Fort Apache Indian Agency.

The foregoing resolution Number 238 was on January 19, 1948 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and none against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
