

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 2nd day of February, 1948, that,

In order to promote the development of the mineral deposits on the Fort Apache Reservation that the application of Charles O. Reidhead of Phoenix, Arizona for a lease on certain mining claims to mine and mill asbestos ore are hereby approved, provided that mining leases duly drawn on Interior Department forms are completed and duly approved by the Council and the Commissioner of Indian Affairs in accordance with regulations governing mining leases (Title 25, C.F.R.), and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized to sign said mining leases for the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on February 2nd, 1948, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c), of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
