

RESOLUTION OF THE  
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Roberta Colelay, age 4, is seriously in need of a brace to aid her in learning to walk following a serious illness and since her parents Robert and Hazel Colelay are willing to obtain the necessary appliance for the child but do not have the necessary funds, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 2nd day of February, 1948 does hereby authorize the expenditure of \$47.50 from tribal relief funds previously appropriated for the purchase of the necessary brace for Roberta Colelay, a member of the Tribe, with the provision that Robert Colelay shall repay the full amount to the Tribe in monthly payments and that the full amount shall be repaid on or before December 31, 1948.

The foregoing resolution was on February 2nd, 1948, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
