

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT A. AGUIZ INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 6th day of May, 1948, that,

In order to encourage worthwhile recreation by the Indians of various communities and to assist them in obtaining equipment for baseball teams, that there be hereby authorized and appropriated from tribal funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency, the sum of \$100.00, provided that not to exceed \$100.00 be used by the baseball team for the East Fork team for baseball equipment, and not to exceed \$50.00 for the purchase of baseballs and other equipment for teams from other districts who have previously had assistance from the Council.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on May 4, 1948, by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (4), of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 16, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 12, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
