

RESOLUTION OF THE  
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, There is need for additional housing for tribal employees at Whiteriver, and,

WHEREAS, there is available for purchase from a member of the tribe a well-constructed four-room cottage located at Whiteriver,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the four-room cottage owned by Mrs. Bessie Printup, a member of the tribe, is hereby authorized. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$3,000.00 of tribal funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency for the purchase of the Bessie Printup cottage, and not to exceed \$500.00 for painting, repairs and reconditioning of the sewer system.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that by the acquisition of this property that it might be assigned to tribal or agency employees with the provision that suitable rent will be paid to the tribe for the use of the cottage, such rent to be determined by the Council, but in no case to be less than charged government employees for comparable quarters. Provided further that funds received for rent of said cottage may be applied towards maintenance and upkeep of the property upon approval of the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on May 4, 1948, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
