

RESOLUTION
of the
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE
of the
FORT APACHE RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Reservation this 8th day of June, 1948, that the following described land, located in the Town of McNary, Arizona is hereby authorized to be used for school purposes:

"Located within the boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Apache County, Arizona and lying in the unsurveyed Town of McNary, Arizona comprising a parcel of land 300 feet fronting Fir Street on the south, 316.7 feet fronting Pollock Avenue on the west, 300 feet fronting Spruce Street on the north, 316.7 feet fronting McCaffey Avenue on the east, consisting of 2.18 acres more or less all in Section 19, Township 8 north, Range 24 east of the Gila and Salt River Meridian,"

for the use and occupancy as a school reserve for such period as said land is used for school purposes in the construction or improvement of school facilities in cooperation by the Secretary of the Interior with the Apache County School District No. 23 and for the Apache County High School Board, Apache County, Arizona.

This resolution is the consent of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Arizona, required by the Interior Appropriation Act for the fiscal year 1947 as a condition precedent to the Secretary of the Interior to set aside tribal land at McNary, Arizona, to be used as a school reserve as provided for in that Act.

This resolution revokes Resolution No. 174 which set aside a different tract of land for school purposes, adopted by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe October 14, 1946.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on the 5th day of June, 1948, by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1(c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 384).
