

RESOLUTION  
of the  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE  
of the  
FORT APACHE RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Reservation this 8th day of June, 1946, that

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 167 adopted July 29, 1946 granted an assignment of land for a homestead to Riley Way, an Indian veteran, has not been approved by the Veterans Administration for use of Indian veterans desiring to obtain loans for homebuilding purposes where the Veterans Administration is requested to guarantee such loans pursuant to the Servicemen's Readjustment Act of 1944 as amended, is hereby revoked.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the form of resolution transmitted by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs by letter dated May 19, 1948 (File: 26134-47 SJF) be hereby adopted for all assignments and land for homestead purposes granted to Indian veterans for homebuilding purposes.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on the 8th day of June, 1948, by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(h) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. (84)).
