

RESOLUTION
of the
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE
of the
FORT APACHE RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Riley Way, a member of the Tribe, is hereby granted an assignment of land described as follows:

Lot 1, Block 1 of Indian Homes Addition, Whiteriver, Arizona, said lot being approximately 100 feet wide in front, 200 feet deep, and 75 feet wide in the rear facing the adjacent street.

Said assignment is hereby granted to said Riley Way, the assignee, his heirs or assigns, for the full and exclusive right to occupy the land for homesite purposes for a period of 25 years and for such further period as the said Riley Way, his heirs or assigns, may continue to occupy and use the said land for such homesite purposes. It is expressly stipulated herein that said assignee and his authorized successors in interest may dispose of any buildings that may be erected on the land to another member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe with the approval of the Tribal Council. Said assignee and his authorized successors in interest may sell or otherwise transfer or mortgage any buildings or other improvements placed on the land to any person, firm, corporation or association not a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, provided such sale or other transfer or mortgage shall be approved by the Council but such sale or other transfer or mortgage shall not convey any title to, or interest in, the land on which the buildings or other improvements are situated.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on the 8th day of June, 1948, by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(h) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
