

RESOLUTION
of the
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE
of the
FORT APACHE RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Reservation this 8th day of June, 1948, that

WHEREAS, the StanZona Petroleum Corporation of Phoenix, Arizona has requested permission to make geological surveys on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for the purpose of determining possible oil bearing structures, that said StanZona Petroleum Corporation is hereby authorized to make such studies of the lands of the Fort Apache Reservation as may be required to determine the existence of oil structures; Provided that all applicable regulations are followed, and that no injury to livestock, wildlife or other property or improvements will result from such studies.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on the 8th day of June, 1948, by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
