

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, did in regular session on the 2nd day of December 1946, by Resolution No. 181, recommend appropriation of tribal funds in the amount of \$8,000 for the purpose of paying salaries of forest fire lookouts during the last half of the fiscal year 1947 and the first half of the fiscal year 1948, and,

WHEREAS, this allotment now contains a balance of \$3,848.63,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 12th day of July 1948, that this said balance of \$3,848.63 be made available for the purpose of paying salaries of forest fire lookouts for the last half of the fiscal year 1948 and the first half of the fiscal year 1949.

The foregoing resolution was on July 12, 1948 duly adopted by a vote of _____ for and _____ against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (46 Stat. 984).
