

RESOLUTION
of the
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE
of the
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe
in regular session this 12th day of July, 1948, that,

In order to assist Ralph Johnson, a member of the tribe, in continuing
his postgraduate studies at Haskell Institute, that
there is hereby authorized a loan of not to exceed \$200.00
from Tribal Funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency,

PROVIDED, the applicant will sign a repayment agreement, and,

PROVIDED, that the loan is to be repaid within two years after the
applicant graduates from school.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on July 12, 1948, by a vote
of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White
Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article
VI, Section 1(d), of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe,
ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
