

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that beginning October 1, 1948 a stumpage charge of \$5.00 per thousand board feet measured by log or tree scale, shall be charged for all timber cut for the agency sawmill. All money received under this provision shall be deposited to general tribal funds as other timber sale receipts and be subject to the same deductions for cost of administration as other timber sale receipts. Said payment of stumpage charges may be made quarterly, semi-annually or annually, but in all cases shall be paid in full at the end of each fiscal year for all timber cut during the preceding fiscal year.

The foregoing resolution was on September 13, 1948 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
