

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that savings not exceeding \$2,000.00 in the funds set aside by Resolution No. 252 for predatory animal control may be used for repair on the Canyon Day School building for quarters for the predatory control trapper,

PROVIDED, that the quarters so provided may be used for other tribal or stock association employees at such future time if said quarters are not required for predatory animal control employees.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on October 4, 1948 by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 18 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
