

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the McNary Burn Logging Unit was advertised for sale to the highest bidder, and

WHEREAS, the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc. of McNary, Arizona, did on August 31, 1948, profer a high bid of \$12.85 per M for all species,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in special session this 1st day of November, 1948, that the bid of the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc. be accepted and that the Chairman of the Tribal Council be herewith authorized to sign the contract covering the sale of timber on the McNary Burn Logging Unit in behalf of the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on November 1, 1948, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
