

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in session this 26th day of May, 1949 that, Iavern West who is not a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe but who is married to Clara Cody West, a member of the Tribe, is hereby prohibited from running his personal livestock on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation. Mr. West is given (20) twenty days from this date, May 26, 1949, to remove his livestock from the reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on May 26, 1949, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Ordinance No. 13 and Article VI, Section 1(h) and 3 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 964).
