

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation that, whereas the funds provided for relief of indigent members of the tribe for fiscal year 1949 as provided in Section 5 of Tribal Resolution 252 were not sufficient for the needs for the entire fiscal year therefore, there is hereby authorized the expenditure of not to exceed \$2,500.00 from tribal funds on deposit of the Fort Apache Agency to meet the deficit of relief purposes which was authorized by motion made and carried and recorded in the minutes of the meeting held March 7, 1949.

The foregoing resolution was on July 11, 1949, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 20, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
