

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT MONTEZUMA INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc., of McNary, Arizona, as purchaser, has a contract on the Maverick Logging Unit, and

AND WHEREAS, in accordance with a request by the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc., a Timber Contract Modification has been prepared permitting a maximum annual cut on the Maverick Unit not to exceed 35 million feet board measure during each of the years ending March 31, 1949 to March 31, 1954 both inclusive, provided that the Commissioner of Indian Affairs may authorize the purchaser to exceed the maximum allowable cut in any such twelve-month period. Provided further that in no event shall the total cut exceed 240 million feet board measure for the ten-year period ending March 31, 1954 or 100 million feet board measure for each of the five-year periods ending March 31, 1950, 1954 and 1959,

IT IS THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 6th day of September, 1949 that the said Modification of Contract covering the Maverick Logging Unit be approved and that the Chairman and Secretary of the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe be hereby authorized to sign the said Modification on behalf of the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1949 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(c) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
