

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, a four-room cottage owned by the White Mountain Apache Tribe and located at Whiteriver, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, Clinton and Dora Kessay, members of the Tribe, are in need of additional housing,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the tribal owned cottage located at Whiteriver known as the Printup house be sold to Clinton and Dora Kessay under a conditional sales contract for a total amount of \$3,500.00 with the provision that the interest at the rate of 3 percent per year be charged on the unpaid balance of the purchase price.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman or Vice Chairman of the Council is hereby authorized to approve in the sales contract between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and Clinton and Dora Kessay for the sale of the cottage named herein.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1949, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
