

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the East Fork Drainage timber cruise fund is about expended, and

WHEREAS, six weeks of field work and several months of office work, including compilation of all data and making of maps, will be required to complete this project,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 3rd day of October, 1949 that an additional allotment of \$2,000 be made from Tribal funds, to the East Fork Drainage Timber Cruise Fund for the purpose of completing that project.

The foregoing resolution was on October _____, 1949 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
