

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 14th day of November, 1949, that;

WHEREAS, the Salt River Asbestos Mining Company Incorporated has requested the use of five acres of land, more or less, for construction and operation of an asbestos mill near the Salt River bridge on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a permit be granted the Salt River Asbestos Mining Company Incorporated for construction and operation of an asbestos mill, and the Chairman or Vice-Chairman of the Council is authorized to approve said permit for the Council.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on November 14, 1949, by a vote of 7 and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
