

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 6th day of December, 1949 that,

WHEREAS, a general representation contract in the form attached hereto with James E. Curry as Chief Attorney and C. M. Wright as Associate Attorney to represent the tribe as its general counsel in all matters other than the prosecution of its claims against the United States is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Fred Larzelere, Vice-Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized to sign said general representation contract which has been approved by the Council for the Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was on December 6, 1949 duly adopted by a vote of \_\_\_\_\_ for and \_\_\_\_\_ against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (b) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
