

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 6th day of December, 1949 that,

WHEREAS, tribal funds on deposit in the Individual Indian Money Account with the Fort Apache Indian Agency in the amount of \$1850 is hereby authorized for the compensation and expenses of the attorneys retained by the tribe under general representation contract approved by Tribal Resolution No. 308; said funds to be available from January 1 to June 30, 1950,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Tribal Resolution No. 292 is here amended to authorized the expenditures outlined herein.

The foregoing Resolution was on December 6, 1949 duly adopted by a vote of _____ for and _____ against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
