

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 6th day of December, 1949 that,

WHEREAS, tribally-owned trucks which have been purchased by the tribe for tribal use only may hereafter be used for individual Indian use, providing the individual requesting such use pay for truck operation at the rate of (15¢) fifteen cents per mile, if said truck is used for private business. Said mileage charge shall be for cash only and no credit is authorized for use of such trucks, provided further that if the tribal truck is required for use of Indians for funeral purposes is hereby authorized without charge.

The foregoing resolution was on December 6, 1949 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (a) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 19, 1934 (48 Stat. 934).
