

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Whiting Brothers, of Holbrook, Arizona, as Purchaser, have a timber contract on the Hop Canyon Unit of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the said contract on the Hop Canyon Unit expires as of March 31, 1949, and

WHEREAS, the said contract on the Hop Canyon Unit will not have been completed as of March 31, 1949,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 7th day of March, 1949 that the timber contract on the Hop Canyon Unit be extended from March 31, 1949 to March 31, 1950.

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 1949 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 18, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
