

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the original contract covering the Forestdale Logging Unit contains a stipulation withholding a certain area of the said Unit for use of the Agency Sawmill, and

WHEREAS, logging activities for the Agency Mill have occurred in an area outside the area stipulated in the original contract as withheld for use of the Agency Sawmill,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 6th day of March, 1950, that the stipulations regarding the area which shall be withheld from the Unit for use of the Agency Sawmill, as set forth in the latter part of the second paragraph of pages 1 and 2 of the original contract, be modified as follows:

"Provided, that from the area herein described there shall be withheld, for the use of the Agency Sawmill, an area containing 4,000,000 feet, more or less, of Ponderosa pine described as follows: beginning at the junction of the Big Springs and Faught Ridge truck-trails, in the south half of section 14; thence north, approximately  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile, to the section line between sections 11 and 14; thence east, along said section line, to the S.E. corner of section 12, Twp. 8N., R. 22N.; thence along the section lines bounding sections 18 and 17 on the north to that point where the west boundary of Unit No. 1 intersects said section line, approximately 20 chains west of the N.E. corner of section 17, Twp. 8N., R. 23 E.; thence in a southeasterly direction, following the west boundary of Unit No. 1 through sections 17, 16 and 21, Twp. 8N., R. 23 N., to the S.E. corner of section 21; thence west along the south section lines of sections 21, 20 and 19 to the S.W. corner of sections 19, Twp. 8N., R. 23E., thence west  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles along the south section lines of sections 24 and 23, Twp. 8N., R. 22 E., thence north one and one-quarter miles to the point of beginning."

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 1950 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
