

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 6th day of March, 1950, that,

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Indian Affairs is hereby requested to transfer \$25000 of Tribal Funds on deposit with the Treasury in the account of, Industrial Assistance Reimbursable, Fort Apache Indian, Arizona, to an Individual Indian Money Account at Fort Apache Indian Agency for revolving credit loans to Indians of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such funds will be used exclusively for loans in accordance with Resolution No. 182 as amended by the Tribal Council on January 6, 1947.

The foregoing Resolution was on the 6th day of March, 1950 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
