

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, in regular session this 31st day of May, 1950 that in order to provide funds for expenses of tribal members detailed to Indian Service Summer School, that the transfer of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) from savings accrued in the various authorizations in Tribal Resolution No. 292, is hereby authorized to be used for summer school expenses.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 31, 1950 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
