

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in special session this 14th day of June, 1950,

WHEREAS, the Superintendent be authorized to advance big check not to exceed three thousand dollars, (\$3000.00) to Paul Simmons, Tribal Clerk, for cash payment to Fire Fighters. Funds disbursed to be accounted for by securing itemized signed receipts for all payments. Paul Simmons will be Bonded to the tribe for three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3500.00), premiums to be paid from tribal funds. All payments will be accounted for by tribal vouchers supported by signed receipts and at the end of the fire season all cash will be returned to the appropriate tribal account.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 14, 1950 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 ( ) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1954 (48 Stat. 984).
