

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache  
Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation  
that,

WHEREAS, there are on deposit in the Individual Indian Money  
Account with the Superintendent of the Fort  
Apache Indian Agency, tribal funds in excess  
of current needs that the Council hereby  
authorized to purchase two hundred thousand  
dollars (\$200,000.00) of United States Govern-  
ment Bonds in the name of the White Mountain  
Apache Tribe. Said bonds to be purchased  
from funds now on deposit in the Individual  
Indian Money account at Fort Apache Indian  
Agency to the credit of the tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was on the 14th day of July,  
1933 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against,  
by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe  
pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1  
(d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified  
by the Tribe on August 15, 1933 and approved by the Secre-  
tary of the Interior on August 26, 1933 pursuant to Section  
18 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
