

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the contract covering sale of timber on the Lost Tank Canyon Unit contains a paragraph No. 9, which reads as follows: "It is further understood and agreed that stumpage rates shall never, in any event, be reduced below the basic minimum rates of:

\$4.00 per M ft., gross tree scale for Ponderosa Pine,

\$3.00 per M ft., gross tree scale for Douglas Fir and Mexican White Pine, or below \$1.00 per M ft., gross tree scale for other species,"

AND WHEREAS, the above quoted paragraph has not received approval by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 7th day of August, 1950, that paragraph No. 9 of the contract covering sale of timber on the Lost Tank Canyon Unit be hereby approved.

The foregoing Resolution was on August 7, 1950, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 964).
