

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 7th day of August, 1950 that,

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that the construction and installation of a pipeline to bring water supply to the Indian Homes north of the Agency is urgently needed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that funds in the amount of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) be authorized for the expenditure for labor and materials to install a pipeline to Blocks 17, 18 and 19, North Chitariver Subdivision for the benefit of the tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was on August 7, 1950 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 964).
