

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED: by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session on September 11, 1950 that,

WHEREAS, in order to improve stock water facilities in the Sheep Springs area that funds received for the sale of fishing permits is hereby authorized to be used for the construction of water tanks along Snake Creek, the amount not to exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00). Said appropriation to be from Tribal Funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency.

The foregoing resolution was on September 11, 1950 duly adopted by a vote of 3 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by articles VI, section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 13, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
