

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in order to protect the interests of the Tribe, that public liability and property damage insurance for all tribally owned and operated trucks is believed desirable and authorization for said insurance is hereby granted, PROVIDED said insurance premiums are to be paid from funds authorized and provided for the operation of said trucks, and PROVIDED further that future budgets covering truck purchases and operations shall include necessary insurance premiums.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 6, 1960 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
