

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that savings not exceeding \$1000 in funds available for repairs and rebuilding reservation boundary fences provided in Resolution No. 292, Section 5, Item (c) are hereby authorized for expense of revising the reservation range maps and for completion of the timber unit maps and management plan work of the East Fork Timber Unit.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 6, 1950 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
