

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that authorization is hereby granted the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency to repay gratuity appropriations for welfare, Public Assistance, the amount of three thousand eight hundred eighty-seven dollars (\$3887.00) which was erroneously paid from gratuity funds and which should have been paid from Tribal Relief Funds. The erroneous payments and the amounts paid to the respective persons are listed on schedule attached hereto, and repayment is to be made from relief funds of the tribe heretofore authorized for such purposes.

The foregoing Resolution was on the 4th day of June, 1951 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 964).
