

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that,  
WHEREAS, Paul Johnson and his wife, Daisy Johnson, have been operating  
a small store at East Fork Bridge near the mission and,  
WHEREAS, Paul Johnson and his wife, Daisy Johnson, have both been con-  
victed in the tribal court on numerous occasions for  
drunkenness and disorderly conduct,  
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the White Mountain Apache  
Tribe that the authority of the council for Paul Johnson  
to operate said store is hereby revoked and the Area  
Director is respectfully requested to cancel traders  
license of Paul Johnson to operate said store.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 10, 1951 duly adopted by a vote  
of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain  
Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 3  
of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on  
August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26,  
1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
