

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that tribal funds on deposit in the Individual Indian Money Account with the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency in the amount not to exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2500) it is hereby authorized for the purchase of a suitable automobile for use for the Special Officer employed by the tribe on law and order work and Resolution No. 51-15 is hereby amended accordingly.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 10, 1951 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
