WHEREAS; Our present Superintendent Mr. R. D. Helts is being transferred into the Phoenix Area Office as Area Forester and;


WHEREAS; Area Director Galvin has met with the Council and discussed the appointment of Mr. John O. Crew to be our next superintendent,

The Council farther wishes to express pleasure and satisfaction for the appointment of Mr. Crew as our next superintendent.

The Council wishes to extend every welcome to Mr. Crew and his family and to pledge to Mr. Crew the assistance and cooperation of the council looking forward to a long and pleasant relationship.

The foregoing Resolution was on the 10th day of July, 1951 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (a) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
