

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Indian Reorganization Act requires advance submission to the tribes of all estimates of appropriation;

WHEREAS, for sixteen years the Indian Bureau failed to comply with the provision;

WHEREAS, this tribe and others last year demanded compliance with the law and the Indian Bureau for the first time complied with the law but submitted the estimates too late to permit full discussion;

WHEREAS, said estimates have not yet this year been submitted to the tribe and the time for doing so is almost gone,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council again demands compliance by the Department of the Interior with legal requirements as to submission of budget estimates.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 10, 1951 duly adopted by a vote of \_\_\_\_\_ for and \_\_\_\_\_ against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (a) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
