

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in order to provide additional funds for certain tribal activities, Tribal Resolution No. 50-21 adopted by the Council on May 31, 1950 is hereby amended to provide additional funds for expenditure during the current fiscal year as follows:

SECTION 5 (a) Control of Juniper is hereby increased by twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00), such funds to be used for pay of Indian workers and operation of limited heavy equipment in eradication of juniper from tribal range lands.


SECTION 5 (e) An additional two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) made available for pay of bounties for elimination of predatory animals under such rules as have heretofore been established.


SECTION 6 (d) Relief of indigent Indians is hereby increased by ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to provide needed welfare assistance to indigent members of the tribe who are not eligible for welfare payments under the State and Federal Social Security Programs.

The funds hereby appropriated are to be expended from available tribal funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Indian Agency to the credit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe from receipts of sale of tribal cattle.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these funds are to be made available immediately and be available for necessary expenditure until June 30, 1951.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 5, 1951 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
