

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, by resolution No. 292, adopted May 2, 1949, the amount of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) was appropriated for the development of domestic water supply and pipe lines for the Canyon Day Village, and

WHEREAS, this project is incomplete and the funds appropriated have been expended,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that an additional amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) be hereby appropriated for completion of this project from funds on deposit in an Individual Indian Money Account with the Fort Apache Agency.

The foregoing resolution was on December 3, 1951 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
